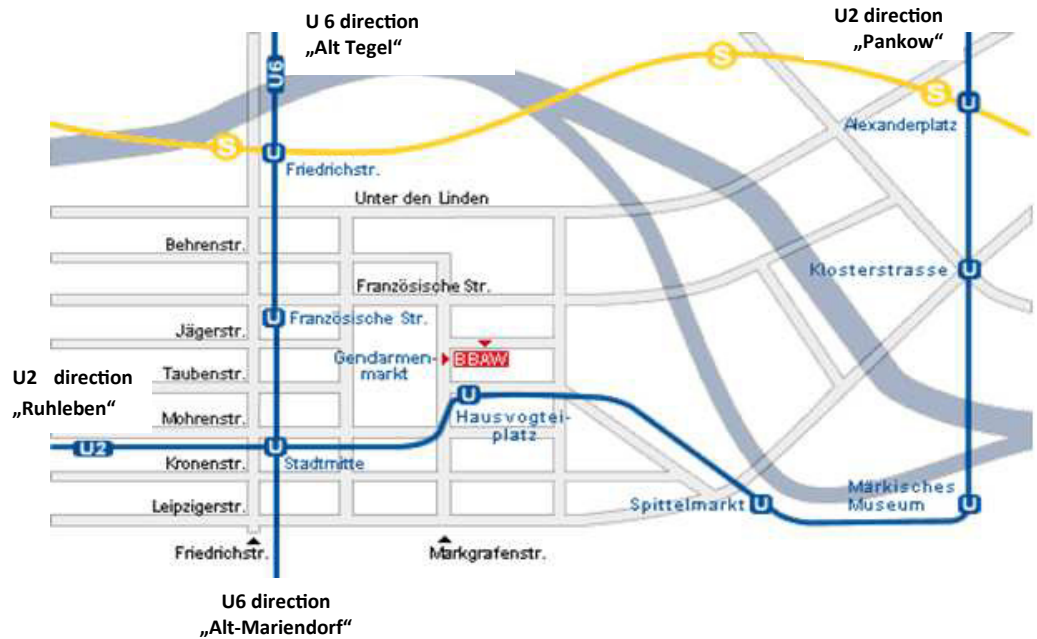

## How to get there

The Berlin-Brandenburg Academy of Sciences and Humanities can be reached by using public transport (BVG). The nearest subway stations are “Hausvogteiplatz” (red line U2) and “Französische Straße” (purple line U6).



---

### From airport Tegel (TXL):

Take the airport bus X9 direction “S+U Zoologischer Garten” till “U Ernst-Reuter-Platz”. Change to the red subway line U2, direction “S+U Pankow” till “U Hausvogteiplatz”. Walking distance is 2 minutes.

### From airport Schönefeld (SXL):

Please be sure to buy a ticket for zone C. Take the airport bus X7 direction “U Rudow” until final stop. Change to blue subway line U7, direction “S+U Rathaus Spandau” till “U Mehringdamm”. Change to the purple subway line U6, direction “U Französische Straße” until final stop “U Französische Straße”. Walking distance is about 5 minutes.

### From central station (Hauptbahnhof):

Take the bus 147 direction “S Ostbahnhof via Friedrichstraße” till stop “Jerusalemmer Straße”. Walking distance is about 6 minutes.

### Taxi:

Taxi service is available from both airports to the city centre. Prices range from 25-30 EUR (from Tegel) and 40-45 EUR (from Schönefeld).
